


'Conservation, Sustainability and Global Demand for U.S. Soy'

Soy's Versatility Hits the Green



Soy's many uses continues to expand beyond food, livestock nutrition and fuel. Soy's innovation may even reach golf balls. Researchers at Pittsburg State University in Kansas are testing the opportunity to replace oil-based plastics that go into making golf balls with materials made from soybean oil. The initial research appears promising. The Missouri Soybean Merchandising Council is leading this project. Learn more about the latest research here.

Soy-Based Plastics Not Favored by Rodents

A recent <u>study</u> funded by USB found that rodents didn't find soy-based materials very tasty compared to petroleum-based counterparts. Researchers tested a variety of components of soybean oil, including high oleic soybean oil and even degummed soybean oil. Soy plastic is being used in a variety of products, from vehicle seats to flooring to vehicle wiring. Additionally, soybean oil supplies a cost-effective secondary heat stabilizer and provides a sustainable alternative to petroleum without sacrificing performance.
