

U.S. Soy Achieves Record Export Volume



U.S. soybeans continue to meet the world's nutrition needs, as aggregate volume hit a record for all international exports for the 2020-21 marketing year. The new aggregate volume record reflects efforts to diversify and expand markets and usage.

As additional importers and companies focus on value, the demand for high-quality soybeans continues to grow. As a result, U.S. soybeans remain a premium, sustainable protein. For the 2020-21 marketing year, nearly half of U.S. soybean destination markets grew by at least 10% compared to the 2016-17 marketing year, which was the prior record year for whole soybean exports.
